

I. Fairness in Income and Social Benefits

1. Fairness in **Income** Your taxes will be affected by any unfair surplus income

A YOUR TAXABLE INCOME From Form 1040 Line 38	Enter on Line II. A below	<u> \$ 75,000 </u>
B Number of people in your household	<u> 3 </u>	
C Income per member (divide A by B)	<u> 25,000 </u>	
D Enter 15,000	<u> 15,000 </u>	
E Surplus income (subtract D from C).	Enter on Line II. B below	<u> \$ 10,000 </u>

2. Fairness in **Housing** Your housing will be affected by any unfair surplus of housing

A Enter the square feet of your housing x 10 (2000x10=20,000)	<u> 33,000 </u>	
B Enter the number of people who sleep at your residence	<u> 3 </u>	
C Calculate the number of sf x 10/person (A divided by B)	<u> 11,000 </u>	
D Subtract 5,000 from C	<u> -5,000 </u>	
E Surplus housing benefit Enter Line C minus Line D	Enter on Line II. C below	<u> \$ 6,000 </u>

NOTE: If E is over 5,000 but under 10,000 you will be assigned a new household member
NOTE: If E is over 10,000 you will be assigned a new household member and child

3. Fairness in **Health Care** Your taxes will be affected by any unfair spending on health care

A Enter the amount you spent on hosp-medical care (over 6,000)	<u> 2,000 </u>	
B Enter the amount for dental, eye care and RX (over 6,000)	<u> -0- </u>	
C ADD these amounts (A+B)	Enter on Line II. D below	<u> \$ 2,000 </u>

4. Fairness in **Education** Your taxes will be affected by any unfair level of educational attainment.

A Your Highest Educational Level: 0. Below HS/HSE 0. HS/HSE 1. AS Degree
 2. BS degree 3. MA degree/s 4. Doctoral degree/s

B Write that number here [3] Multiply that number by 1,000 Enter on Line II. E below \$ 3,000

5. Fairness in **Quality of Living** Your taxes will be affected by any unfair level of quality of living.

A Enter your Unfair Quality of Life number in the Table 7.1 [2] x 1,000 = Enter on Line II. F \$ 2,000

6. Fairness in **Automobile Use** Your taxes will be affected by any unfair level of automobile usage.

A If you drive more than 8,000mi/year, enter 2,500 Enter on Line II. G below \$ 2,500

E Enter your education surplus from line	4-B	<u> \$ 3,000 </u>
F Enter your quality of living surplus from	5-A	<u> \$ 2,000 </u>
G Enter your automobile use surplus from	6-A	<u> \$ 2,500 </u>
H Add the TOTAL of UNFAIR Surplus Income		<u> \$ 25,500 </u>
I Add the total. This is your FAIR taxable income. Enter on 1040 Line 39.		<u> \$ 100,500 </u>
